<p>Just installed/updated qgis-master on two Ubuntu 11.10 machines.</p> <p>When adding a WMS layer it doesn't show anymore how many bytes is downloading, it just shows a few numbers, not sure what it is.</p> <p>It seems very slow to add/render WMS layers (if compared with the same servers/layers that worked fine in previous versions of qgis-master).</p> <p>In saved projects it doesn't render anymore WMS layers. Also adding new layers to a already existing project doesn't seems to work.</p>
