<p>If amongst the layers there's a shapefile without features (empty), zooming to all layers leads to an extension of the map with very very small scale (12 digits at denominator!).</p> <p>The issue is independent by the CRS of layers and the map (tried with several CRS and with or without OTF projection).</p>
