<p>I recently loaded and installed QGIS on my work machine. Whenever I try to "add data" the application immediately quits - entirely disappears on me - without any message or acknowledgement thereof. I've tried removing and reinstalling the program 3 times with no change. I'm running Windows XP. Interestingly I tried installing the program on my home machine (also running XP) and had NO PROBLEMS - could add data and such. I've spoken with my network guru and he ran me through some trouble shooting avenues with no success. Any help would be greatly appreciated.</p> <p>Thanks, Jake Hewes</p>
