<p>When editing the attribute table of a vector layer with the multi attribute editing tool an array should be generated to be inserted into postgresql. This array is formatted as {1,2,3}.</p> <p>If only one value is inserted, the array should be {1}. But if only one value is checked (which is not the first one in the list) the resulting array looks like this: {,3}. This is not accepted by postgresql.</p> <p>The attached patch solves this problem. Please review and apply.</p>
