Description

Large rasters in print composer show white ghost lines. Ghost lines are not present in original data, they are not visible on map canvas. They are present only in composer and it's output (i.e. PNG image). Exact location of ghost lines changes when changing output scale. Vector data are not affected.

Steps to reproduce:

- Add raster map to QGIS
- Visualize it in print composer
- Zoom-in to see map at approx. 100% zoom
- Play around with scales/extents till thin (1px wide) white lines appear
