<p>The result of the sql-statement on an Access-db is stored into a temporary file (f.e. &lt;datasource&gt;file:///C:/Users/MICHAEL~1.WTN/AppData/Local/Temp/qt_temp.IE1500?delimiter=%09&amp;delimiterType=regexp&amp;xField=Easting&amp;yField=Northing&lt;/datasource&gt;). Because the file was deleted by QGIS QGIS crashes after re-opening the file.</p>
