- 4. Set scale to 1:3390
- 5. Center map to roundabout located at 492052,1279353
- 5. Notice the label "Rongvong Mul Wat Phnom" label
- 6. Switch project's CRS to EPSG:4326 (WGS84)
- 7. Notice the absence of label, even though there's enough space on line.
