Description <p>A request on the mailing list concerning a problem, the solution for would be a a concave hull function leads, to this feature request. I found a discussion on the mailing list from jan. 2012 (http://lists.osgeo.org/pipermail/qgis-user/2012-January/014970.html) and discovered more info on stackexchange (http://gis.stackexchange.com/questions/1200/concave-hull-definition-algorithms-and-practical-solutions), but so far no ticket on this matter here.</p> <p>Even though a concave hull function is availabe in postgis 2.0 and will be in spatialite 4.0, for ordinary users without sql knowledge, there will be no way to perform such actions.</p> <p>There seems to be a lot work done on this field already, but didn't find the way into a plugin so far.</p> <p>I suggest a concave hull function alongside of the convex hull function in fTools, with similar option to choose an attribute for creating individual hulls over related objects.</p>
