<b>Description</b>		
<p>Create a closed line loop using snapping that starts and finishes on the same point.</p> <p>Split that line, and the beginning and end points move to the split, the originals are lost.</p> <p>That is the line is not split - its origin (start and end point) is changed - it is still a closed single line.</p> <p>Happens in shapefile or postgis.</p> <p>Simple user work around - move one end of the line so it is no longer closed, then split it - works as expected.</p> <p>This happens on qgis version 1.7.4 and 1.8.0.</p>
