Description		
<p>Openstreetmap plugin saves data in a temporary database. When saving and reopening a project with OSM data, I get the "bad layer handling" dialogue for the layers OSM plugin had created.</p> <p>The downloaded data and database are still in temp directory, but the plugin can't open the layers.</p> <p>Exporting to shapefile or spatialite is not an option, because the styling from OSM plugin can not be copied to other layers.</p> <p>Tested on Qgis Lisboa and current Master.</p>
