<b>Description</b> <p>I can connect a custom form to both a spatial and a non-spatial spatialite table. But only for the spatial table is the attribute editor layout setting (properties-fields tab) stored in the qgis project file.</p> <p>I think this is a regression since it earlier was possible to connect a custom form to a non-spatial table and also keep information about this connection in the qgis project file.</p> <p>A sample qgis project, spatialite db and custom form is attached. See project file where &lt;editorlayout&gt;uifilelayout&lt;/editorlayout&gt; is only set for the spatial table.</p>
