<b>Description</b>  Hi qgis developers, I don't know who to contact, but thanks for all your hard work in providing this program! Yesterday I tried to install qgis on two more machines running ubuntu and I am unable to do so. I successfully installed qgis on yet a different desktop running the same OS last week. When looking at package synaptics I noticed that the successfully installed version is 1.9.0+git20121208+7841975~precise-ubuntugis1 for ALL packages. Some of the packages have been updated in the last week to version 1.9.0+git20121210+df2c1c5~precise-ubuntugis1 and when trying to install qgis as of yesterday I get the report that 'qgis-providers' and 'python-qgis' contain broken packages and it will not install. I'm not sure who works on this kind of problem or if anyone knows about.
