<b>Description</b>  Print composer does not display an attribute table as shown in the attachment. The attribute table is there because it has properties. The only reason why the outline is shown is because I was moving it when gimp captured the screen. This has gradually been getting worse in the past few days - on the 25 Jan 2013 the table was drawn but the values were not displayed (only just got around to reporting the problem).
