QGIS has a number of "marker line" symbol types. When i export these to SLD they become <qraphic><mark><wellknowntext> elements

However two of them appear to go against the spec for mark element types.

"rectangle" - the spec says this should be "square"

"cross2" - this should be "x"

The spec says other items can be created as desired, but as these two correlate with each other and are mandatory I figure they should probably be using the spec-defined names for consistency with other applications.

This applies to SLD 1.0 and 1.1.
