<p>Following #6921</p> <p>With master I get a different bug.</p> <p>Using either:</p> <p><a href="http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.1.0">http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.1.0</a></p> <p>or</p> <p><a href="http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.3.0">http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.3.0</a></p> <p>The following happens.</p> <p>When I click connect I get this error:</p> <p>"The WFS server does not support WFS version 1.0".</p> <p>There are several problems here:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The WFS server /does/ support all three versions of WFS (its GeoServer)</li><li>- There is no "WFS 1.0". There is a WFS 1.0.0, 1.1.0 and 1.3.0</li><li>- I've just requested WFS 1.1.0 or 1.3.0. Not 1.0.0</li></ul> <p>This doesn't happen if I use:</p> <p><a href="http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.0.0">http://wppgeog3:8082/geoserver/wfs?version=1.0.0</a></p> <p>I appreciate QGIS probably doesn't support them, but the error should be correct.</p>
