<p>Hi, I am having trouble running any python plugin in 1.9.0-Master Master, 51f2383 on Ubuntu 12.10. As this seems to affect all plugins, including functions from the vector menu, and because the same plugins are running fine in QGIS 1.8, I am reporting it here.
