<p>First of all - a cool feature!</p> <p>Even cooler by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Make a "Copy row" button - often the rows will be very much alike with only one parameter changed</li><li>2) Make it possible to select input layer from the open Qgis project</li><li>3) It was unexpected to me that output is not automatically opened in the Qgis project which is the default in normal Execute (at first I thought no output was produced at all)</li><li>4) Also the definition of output files took me some time to figure out - it appears you have to be very specific by selecting folder, name and file extension unlike other parts of Sextante</li></ol>
