<p>In the QGIS web client try set up a simple search, then try search for two words separated by a space. A message will pop up</p> <p><i>The filter string "nome" = 'penela penela' has been rejected because of security reasons. Note: Text strings have to be enclosed in single or double quotes. A space between each word / special character is mandatory. Allowed Keywords and special characters are AND,OR,IN,&lt;,&gt;=,&gt;,&gt;=,!=",',',(,),DMETAPHONE,SOUNDEX. Not allowed are semicolons in the filter expression.</i></p> <p>At first I supposed was a configuration problem or a client bug, then with firebug I realized that the message comes from the server. The URL with the request has the words between "" but it returns anyway the error. Not sure if is a regression, this has been observed on qgis master.</p>
