- 1. shapefile comes with .sbn and .sbx index files from ESRI client
- 2. edit in QGIS, which does not maintain ESRI indexes.
- 3. Open shapefile again in ArcView (tested in 3.2 and 9.2) and shapefile appears corrupted, with many features missing. Even a 'bit in range' failure in AV 3.2.
- 4. delete .sbn and .sbx files and shapefile works perfectly

Solution: Whenever a shapefile is opened for editing (or when first commit is made) by QGIS, automatically delete ESRI index files if they exist.
