<p>1. Open the attached QGIS project (test-blend.zip)</p> <p>2. Have a look at beautiful rendering of raster heatmap (with 'difference' blend mode) over streets vector</p> <p>3. Open print composer 'Composer 1'</p> <p>4. Notice how the composer's map item has it all wrong, as if the raster black to white was reversed, or the layer order switched</p> <p>If the user exports the composer to a PNG, the exported map is rendering properly. There's only an issue with the composer's map item preview. Also, other blend modes, like multiply, are not triggering this bug.</p>
