<p>Hi !</p> <p>Along with the new blending modes for layers, would it be possible to set a layer's opacity ?</p> <p>The feature already exists in the "transparency" tab, for raster layers.</p> <p>For vector layers, the only solution is to set transparency for individual elements. But then, when you've got overlapping elements, transparency is applied indepently, making multi-layer symbols look bad.</p> <p>Thanks !</p>
