<b>Description</b>  I get a new record full of NULL values in Attribute Table when I try to add a new feature to a vector layer using a custom UI ("Attribute editor layout" set to "Provide ui-file" in layer properties). The imported attributes from the shape file are instead correct. It doesn't happen with an autogenerated UI.
