<p>The attached sextante modeler merging algorithm fails under current master build (rev. eda9cd3). It seems the merged output isn't properly outputted to the sextante's temporary directory.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Load the simple_merge.model into sextante modeler2. Run the model, and input three raster layers (this is done to automate landsat manipulations, but any raster layers will do), click on ok.3. After a few seconds, an error message will appear, which says: "Oooops! SEXTANTE could not open the following output layers"
