<p>QGIS could improve the non default ( ) use project CRS / ( ) use default CRS displayed below settings for loaded layer with no CRS (for e.g. shapefile with missing .prj) by making use of the new message bar.</p> <p>Currently, when relying on these non default options, QGIS will <i>silently</i> attribute a CRS to loaded layer with missing CRS without informing the user it has done so. This is, imo, a bad behavior, even when someone selected the option.</p> <p>With the new non-intrusive message bar that nicely overlay the qgis canvas and automatically closes itself, it'd be nice for QGIS to throw a "The {project CRS,default CRS} has been applied to the loaded layer has it had no defined CRS". It leaves the user fully aware of what's happening, possibly informing him/her of a problem with missing CRS, while not encumbering workflow.</p> <p>It could also provide useful indicator for users who did not wish for these non default options to be selected but ended up set accidentally.</p>
