<p>The plugin manager now shows an error, if the domain could not be resolved or other network related errors.</p> <p>If I enter a random valid and reachable URL which does not contain a repository file it looks as if the repository is being loaded, when in fact it's not. Also, the HTTP status code is not checked.</p> <p>It would be nice and spare some people headache (e.g. when trying to load a repo from behind a proxy) if a meaningful error would be provided.)</p>
