<p>I do not have a clear recipe to replicate this, just use DB manager for a while as a normal user would do, add layers, run queries, preview tables and layers, etc. Then delete a table or view, very often QGIS freezes. Reopen it and try again deleting that table/view and will work ok.</p>
