| <p>When snap to grid is enabled, changing grid spacing and selection tolerance don't seem to change placement behaviour : selection is always snapped to the grid, even if tolerance is changed.</p> <p>For instance, with a 50x50 spacing and a tolerance of 5, I believe it should allow to place an item at 20 of a point of the grid.</p> |                       |                                      |
