<p>I am using QGIS 1.8 on Windows 7 (I've tried 1.8.0-5 and 1.8.0-7)</p> <p>I want to perform a point in polygon analysis using the Vector > Analysis Tools menu.</p> <p>My point layer is the result of a Spatialite query which returns 10'000 points.</p> <p>My polygon layer is a simple shapefile with about 150 different polygons. Both layers are in WGS84 (EPSG:4326).</p> <p>When I click the "OK" button in the Point in Polygon tool, just nothing happens. The progress bar stays at 0%, but I cannot click "Cancel" (i.e. nothing happens).
