<p>In QGIS 1.7 you can select and copy/paste features to an mysql-db and both geometry and attributes work as expected.</p> <p>In QGIS 1.8 only geomtery is copied and all attributes is 'filled' with NULLs.</p> <p>We have tried all config possible, have 1.7.4 and 1.8.0 side by side and can not get it to work in 1.8.</p>
