It's therefore impossible to install QGIS 2.0.1 on Wheezy without the "apt-pinning" trick.</p> <p>The file <a href="http://qgis.org/debian/dists/wheezy/Release">http://qgis.org/debian/dists/wheezy/Release</a> has a bad suite tag: <del>suite: testing</del> should be <b>suite: stable</b> since Debian stable is 'Wheezy' and no longer 'Squeeze'</p>
