<b>Description</b>		
<p>While the default of not showing overlapping elements makes sense for labels, it is less reasonable for diagrams, where a partial overlap is better than missing some.</p> <p>Furthermore, the option to show them all is hidden in obscure (for average user) options.</p> <p>My suggestions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- enable "show all" by default</li><li>- put the option to remove the overlapping ones in the main dialog, easy to find.</li></ul>
