Description I have a Model in which I intersect 1 vector with 17 other vectors. Everytime I run it I have to indicate the 17 vectors, even though they are always the same. It would be useful to be able to program the Modeler to "freeze" some parameter choices (i.e. tell it to fill a Vector layer with ~/home/shapefile1.shp or to fill it with a layer loaded into a project)
