<p>Hi,</p> <p>when opening an existing project using expressions or sql queries in Rule based classes or labels or feature subset, if expression cannot be evaluated, no warning is raised.</p> <p>For example, the data field names have changed.</p> <p>User have some empty classes, or totally empty classes or labels, and finding why can be long.</p> <p>Having a soft warning would be sufficient. Something like "expression XXX on layer (labeling / style) could not be evaluated... please check"</p> <p>Cheers</p> <p>Régis</p>
