I am using ubuntuqgis repositories. the following is the error</p> <p>The following packages have unmet dependencies: python-qgis : Depends: python-qgis-common (= 2.1.0+git20131024+fc74f66~raring-ubuntuqgis1) but it is not going to be installed Depends: sip-api-9.2 but it is not installable E: Unable to correct problems, you have held broken packages.</p> <p>I have realised that the sip-api is now version 10.1 installed. How do i revert back or correct the error.</p>
