<p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Create a new composer window</li><li>2. Add a map item</li><li>3. Make sure you have the move / resize item tool activated</li><li>3. Zoom into the composer far enough to have plenty of panning to do around</li><li>4. Hold the space bar to start panning by moving mouse around</li><li>5. While space bar is held, click and hold mouse's left click button over an item, and then further move the mouse</li><li>6. You'll notice the item is actually being moved</li></ol> <p>What should happen is probably that when spacebar is held down to pan, all the mouse clicks are ignored.</p>
