Description

Under the stable QGIS version 2 and Night Build QGIS 2.1 DEV 47b055f and prior ones, when we use the Processing toolbox and select any grass module that need an extent definition or zone selection from canvas (for instance v.voronoi), the selection square is an opaque red box. This opaque fill is not needed or, at least, this box should be semi-transparent. Otherwise it's impossible to see correctly what is below the area being selected. This must be corrected as soon as possible. Cheers
