<p>Add a point vector layer and make the size of the symbols dependent of any field, using the "advanced" button ("champ de proportion).</p> <p>Open the print composer and export to PDF or PNG: the points in the exported image are (much) bigger than on screen.</p> <p>This happens whether I use map units or mm to define the size of the symbols. It doesn't happen when I use no size scale field.</p> <p>(Ubuntu / Mint)</p>
