<p>This idea was taken from Arcgis and was suggested by people that do a lot of attributes editing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the user selects a column (as in a normal spreadsheet application)</li><li>- then the user selects records/rows</li><li>- then it right click the mouse and a dialog shows</li><li>- in the field place there is the Field Calculator shortcut</li><li>- when open the FC is set to update the selected column and records</li></ul>
