Hi, even if I worked with .CSV files already in QGIS 2.0 I now somehow managed to get my instance not allowing to go to edit-mode anymore. I was unable to find out what it is and even at stackexchange nobody knows why.

If you add the CSV as table, then is editable, if you add it as a point layer then it is not. I believe that is a ogr limitation rather than a qgis one.
