Hi, I recognized that if you add a point layer and like to show labels (e.g. to display a value per item), you get (IMHO) ugly default settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- font: Ubuntu- flags: Bold- size: 11 The result is that you have a little bit ugly layout, as the font looks a bit like Comic Sans/Modern/... and isn't a good choice for serious mapping, similar for the big characters. So I suggest the following defaults that (IMHO) look a bit more serious for most scenarios: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- font: Arial- size: 8- no flags
