<p>Currently map edge in the print composer is not an obstacle for vector feature labels, thus labels of objects located at the edge of map composition are not visible at all or are partially visible - part of them is "behind" map edge.</p> <p>It would be nice to have checkbox somewhere in labelling configuration "map edge is an obstacle" to force new labelling engine to take into account map edge while calculating optimum label placement.</p>
