<p>Here's a strange one... Using Ubuntu, it's impossible to select the "Regular" variant of the "Ubuntu" font in label properties. I can select Regular variants for other fonts (eg Arial), and other variants of the "Ubuntu" font, but everytime I select regular for ubuntu it just changes the dropdown box back to the previous setting.</p>
