<b>Description</b>		
<p>Right now, the X and Y position value of an item is a value that reflects the absolute position within the qgis composer sheet. For example, a second page label item's Y position would be:</p> <p>----</p> <p>page one height (297 units)</p> <p>----</p> <p>page gab (small 20ish units)</p> <p>----</p> <p>location of label item on page two (100 units)</p> <p>Y value: 317</p> <p>That's not a very user friendly way of dealing with the X and Y value when preparing a page. The values should be relative to the page the selected item is in.</p>
