<b>Description</b>  1) Add a shapefile 2) Go into its style properties 3) Change to "Graduated" symbol. 4) Press "Classify".  You'll now get an error: "Renderer creation has failed"  This is almost certainly because a column to classify against wasn't specified. However the error should be a user friendly one: "Please select a Column to classify."  Alternately, just add "no value", which is what happens when this is done with "categorised" style type.
